

### About the Palace Museum:

Established in 1925, the Palace Museum was installed in the imperial palace of two consecutive dynasties - the Ming (1368-1644) and the Qing (1644-1911). The magnificent architecture, also known as the Forbidden City, and the vast holding of the imperial collections of paintings, calligraphy, ceramics, and decorative objects make it one of the most prestigious museums in China and the world at large. In 1961 the imperial palace was designated by the State Council as one of China's foremost-protected cultural heritage sites, and in 1987 was made a UNESCO World Heritage site.

### Getting to the Palace Museum:

By Bus:

To the Gate of Divine Prowess (*Shenwu men*), take bus No. 101, 103, 109, 124, 609, 619, 614, 685, Zhuan 1, Zhuan 2, to "Gugong". (Please note that the Gate of Divine Prowess will be used only as the EXIT of the museum since 2 July 2011)

To the Meridian Gate (*Wu men*), take bus No.1, 10, 120, 126, 2, 20, 37, 52, 59, 728, 82, 99, Zhuan 1, Zhuan 2 to "Tian'an Men East" (*Tian'an men dong*).

Or take bus No. 1, 10, 22, 37, 5, 52, 728, 99, Zhuan 1, Zhuan 2, to "Tian'an men West" (*Tian'an men xi*).

By Subway:

Take Subway line 1 to "Tian'an men East" or "Tian'an men West".

### Parking:

There is no parking outside the north and the south gates of the Palace Museum. The following public parking lots are located in the vicinity of the Forbidden City:

\*Outside the East Prosperity Gate (*Donghua men*) ;

\*In the back street of Jingshan Park;


\*In front of the Front Gate of Beihai Park

Visitors are encouraged to visit the Museum via public transportation.

### Taxi Stands:

According to the local traffic regulations, taxis are not allowed to stop at the Gate of Divine Prowess (*Shenwu men*). Visitors exiting this gate need to walk further either east or west to hail a taxi. Taxis are not available along Chang'an Avenue, which is in front of the Gate of Heavenly Peace (*Tian'an men*), the southern access to the Meridian Gate.
